FDA Grants Emergency Use Authorization for the Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine

**FEB 26**

50 Million COVID-19 Vaccine Doses Administered

**MAR 31**

Pfizer/BioNTech Release Data on Adolescent Vaccination (12-15 year-olds)

**APR 19**

All U.S. Adults Eligible for COVID-19 Vaccines

**AUG 3**

70% of U.S. Adults Received At Least One COVID-19 Shot

**SEP 24**

CDC Recommends Boosters for Seniors, High Risk Individuals and Frontline Health Workers

**NOV 29**

CDC Recommends Booster of the Pfizer/BioNTech and Moderna Covid-19 vaccines for everyone 18 and older

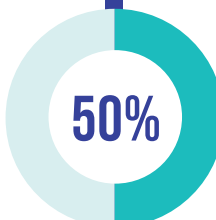


**FEB 27**

50% of U.S. Adults Received At Least One COVID-19 Dose

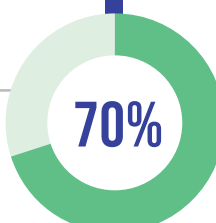


**MAY 10**
