Dear Dr. Cohen and Dr. Califf,

As convening organizations of the <u>COVID-19 Vaccine Education and Equity Project (CVEEP)</u>, we write to share with you our support for the timely authorization and/or approval **of updated COVID-19 vaccines in anticipation of the increased threat of respiratory illnesses this fall.** 

CVEEP was launched in December 2020, mere days before the first COVID-19 vaccines were authorized for use. Today, we are composed of more than 250 partner organizations representing a broad and diverse range of stakeholders, including health care providers, patient and community groups, employers, teachers and first responders, all working to help build confidence in the development process and science around COVID-19 vaccines. Throughout the pandemic we have appreciated the collaboration and active engagement of your agencies in our efforts to provide the latest information and address questions and concerns about COVID-19 vaccines.

As we await guidance on the availability and use of the updated COVID-19 vaccine, we call on our federal agency partners to deliver that vital information as soon as practically possible.

Timing can be everything. With fall and back-to-school on the horizon, so too are the typical seasonal respiratory viruses – including influenza and RSV – and it is paramount that the updated COVID-19 vaccine be available as our family, friends, and neighbors ready themselves to once again roll up their sleeves to gain protection from these viruses.

Simplifying messaging and communications around the importance of the vaccines during this critical point in the calendar will be essential, particularly as the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and others have encouraged co-administration of vaccines and experts warn of yet another "tripledemic" threat. The availability of the updated COVID-19 vaccine coinciding with vaccines for flu and RSV could allow us to improve vaccine uptake and reduce preventable illness.

We have full confidence in the U.S. Food and Drug Administration's (FDA) gold-standard review process and the CDC's recommendation process that have led the way in the vaccine rollout to date and are certain that your agencies can once again meet the moment by making the updated COVID-19 vaccine available to the public as expeditiously as possible.
